- Face masks: encouraged, but not required
- Hand-shaking, etc: strongly encouraging no hand shaking or any other type of physical contact

• Social distancing:

- Household families must to sit together
- Tape is laid to guide you in keeping 6 feet apart from everyone not a part of your immediate household

Parking:

- o Park nearby the side of the church you will sit inside:
- o This will be the side you exit the church from

• Entering:

- Enter from the main entrance under the steeple
- Provided upon entering:
 - a handy wipe to wipe your seat where you sit
 - squirt of hand sanitizer for your hands
- We encourage you to bring your own sanitizer with your Bible
- An usher will lead you and your family to a pew to ensure adequate social distancing

• At your pew:

- Select pews will be taped off to identify restricted areas to ensure social distancing
- o Pew Bibles, Hymnals, and pens will not be available
- o Feel free to sing during congregational worship; encouraged to sing with a mask

Tithes and offerings:

- Drop any tithes and offerings in plates positioned strategically throughout the church
- Mailing contributions and online giving is encouraged

• Restrooms:

- o Restrooms will be available for emergencies
- We kindly ask to limit your bathroom use if at all possible
- o Thoroughly wipe down all surfaces and your hands upon finishing

Exiting:
